Roger Woltermann understands the need for a Cancer Center

Roger Woltermann knows first-hand the quality of care available at Central Montana Medical Center (CMMC) and the importance of the new cancer center. His wife Becky died March 10, 2024, after a courageous 16-month battle with cancer.

"I am so pleased CMMC is building this facility," he said. "It's a tough journey when you are a cancer patient or family member. You have to find those things that make life easier, and having cancer care here did that for us."

The Woltermanns are familiar to Central Montanans as they each taught in local public schools for three decades.

Roger and Becky met in second grade in Columbus, Montana. "We were high school sweethearts," Roger said. "She was the only girl I took to the prom."


After graduating high school together in 1968, they both earned their teaching degrees at Montana State University in 1972, then moved to Central Montana for their first teaching jobs.

Roger worked at the Lewistown Junior High School, from which he would retire after 32 years in 2004. Becky taught at Maiden, in the last year that rural school was open, then taught at Moore. She took 10 years off when their three children were little then began teaching third grade in Lewistown, retiring in 2010 from Garfield Elementary with almost 30 years in education.

Roger worked 10 years as a painter after retiring, and Becky got involved with quilting and some substitute teaching. "We enjoyed our retirement and spent a lot of time visiting with our kids and grandkids," Roger said. Their children are Jennifer in Seeley Lake, Montana, Jill in Idaho and Josh in Minnesota. There are eight grandchildren, Roger said, "our elite eight!"

The Woltermann cancer journey began in the summer of 2012 when Becky was diagnosed with breast cancer. After a lumpectomy and radiation, Becky's cancer was undetectable.

But in November 2022, she was diagnosed with metastatic kidney cancer. "She had a lot of pain in her back for way too long," Roger said, "and

it had spread to her lungs and bones, her back and her skull. We knew from day one that it wasn't going to be good, that we would just roll with it and hope and pray for the best and prepare for the worst. We did the best we could."

Except for one week of radiation in Billings, Becky had all her care at CMMC in Lewistown. Dr. G. Scott Smith placed her port for chemotherapy, and all her infusions and care were delivered here.

"Our hospital was awfully good to us," Roger said. "Nothing but high quality and compassionate care from the infusion crew and hospital people, helpful in

so many ways.

"Becky started infusions in December 2022, and the last one was the first week of February 2024. The side effects were horrendous, and she said 'I can't do this anymore.' I didn't agree with her quitting, but I said I would support her decision."

Becky went into Hospice care through CMMC on Feb. 23, 2024, and died March 10. "She was able to spend her last days at home. I knew Hospice was great, and I know now they are really great. They saved me because I was out of gas. What we have here in Hospice is unique and special, and we are very fortunate to have those people."

Because of his experience, Roger knows what the new CMMC cancer center will mean to the people of Central Montana.

"Having radiation therapy and infusions here, and people not having to drive back and forth to Billings or Great Falls or wherever, having to impose on family and friends or stay in a motel - it will be wonderful for people. We could have been home.

"It will be such a boost to have a facility like that. If you live in the Missouri Breaks up north or Judith Gap or Winnett, you're still part of this. This facility is for you, too."

The new cancer center, which will open this spring, has been made possible by generous gifts from the Leona M. and Harry B. Helmsley Charitable Trust, Norm Asbjornson and Larry and Kathi Carrell and by financial support from more than 800 Central Montanans who donated to the fund drive through the Medical Center Foundation. ❖

Central Montana Foundation's (CMF) Annual Meeting and Luncheon is set for Tues., May 27 at noon at the Yogo Inn in the Depot Ballroom.

"We will have our regular Annual Meeting agenda items including reports on activities and highlights of 2024, along with the presentation of the 2024 financial statements detailing activity for the 300+ permanent endowment and pass through funds administered by CMF," said CMF Executive Director Carrie Mantooth.

A highlight of the Annual Meeting is the Friend of the Foundation award to be presented to an individual who has been exemplary in helping CMF achieve its mission to improve life in Central Montana.

The other major item of business at the CMF Annual Meeting is hearing from major grant applicants. Major grants (requests for \$5,000+

are considered just once per year and those applications are due April 1. (Requests under \$5,000 are considered at CMF's monthly meetings.)

CMF has granted millions of funds to not-for-profit and tax-exempt organizations for medical, essential services, educational, civic, cultural and recreational projects since it was founded in 1984.

All of the funding for CMF's grant-making activities is derived from the dividends and interest earned from its unrestricted permanent endowments. The principal remains untouched, providing a source of income into perpetuity.

There are 12 unrestricted endowments, the largest of which is the Mildred Bryte Memorial. Mildred died in 1997 and left the bulk of her more than \$3 million estate to CMF. A portion of the Bryte income is used to fund major grants. The Bryte Estate endowment income also provides for annual gifts to the 11 rural endowments under CMF's umbrella. Any remaining income is available for monthly distribution.

CMF Board of Directors welcomes two new members

Central Montana Foundation (CMF) Board of Directors has two new faces around the table. Travis Willson was appointed by Fergus County to replace director Carl Seilstad, and Jeff Keller was appointed by Bank of the Rockies to replace Scott Chauvet.

"Both of these men bring unique perspectives and skills to our board of directors," said CMF President Dean Comes. "They both understand the Central Montana community and the responsibilities that come with a position as a CMF Director."

Travis Willson

Travis was born in Miles City and raised primarily in Rosebud, where he graduated high school in 1982. His father was a rancher, and Travis followed in his footsteps for many years, working on ranches in eastern Montana before moving to Winifred in 1991 to accept a position on the Walling Ranch.

He and his wife, Becky, who were married in 1984, moved with their young three daughters to Winifred and never looked back, putting down roots there and immersing themselves in the community. Travis took a position with Cenex in 1997 and then opened Winifred Tire in the spring of 2000. Their daughters are grown and have families of their own, and Travis and Becky enjoy being grandparents to three boys.

Travis was elected to the Winifred Town Council in 2005. He took on more responsibility when, in 2015, he agreed to step in to serve the remainder of Winifred Mayor Neil Rich's term, as he was moving. Travis went through several elections and was Winifred's mayor until the end of 2024.

He threw his hat in the ring for Fergus County Commissioner in the spring of 2024, won the election, and took office in January this year. Fergus County has two seats on the CMF Board of Directors, and the Commission appointed Travis to replace long-time commissioner and CMF Director Carl Seilstad, who retired.

"We've had a great deal of activity surrounding Winifred in recent years, so having a Winifred resident on the CMF Board is ideal," said CMF Executive Director Carrie Mantooth. Winifred native Norm Asbjornson has invested millions into his hometown over the last decade or so and has established a growing list of funds with CMF for the benefit of Winifred School and the town.

"The landscape of Winifred has changed drastically since we moved our family here in 1991," Travis said, listing the visible reminders of Norm's generosity like the community center, hotel and restaurant, airport and school improvements, housing, and stockyards. "Norm has infused life into this community. We can't thank him enough for what he's doing."

Travis attended his first CMF meeting in January and said, "I was blown away as to the amount of money and funds CMF is managing." He was al-

ready familiar with the mission of CMF and said he's enjoying learning more about the scope of CMF. "People put a lot of trust in that their money is being put to good use. It's interesting to see the working side of the Foundation."

Between the new challenges of being a county commissioner and serving on a board like CMF, Travis is absorbing a great deal of new information. "If you can't learn something new every day, you're not doing anything," he quipped.

Jeff Keller

Bank of the Rockies appointed Jeff Keller to the CMF Board of Directors in January. Jeff is the bank's Fergus County Market President and Vice President of Residential Real Estate Lending.

Jeff grew up primarily in Harlowton, and finished out high school at Fergus, graduating in 1988. He earned a bachelor's degree in Economics and Business Management from Rocky Mountain College in Billings. He has 32 years of executive leadership experience within the banking and real estate lending financial platforms, working with companies including Morgan Stanley and DR Horton. Jeff lived in Texas since 1992, working in Fort Worth, Houston, Frisco, Austin and Dallas.

He's pleased to be back "home" in Central Montana and enjoys spending time with his wife of 26 years, Robyn, and their two adult daughters, Sophie and Summer. Sophie is currently pursuing her master's degree at the Chicago School of Professional Psychology with emphasis in forensic psychology, while Summer is finishing her undergrad degree in

communications with double minors in marketing and social work, and will be attending University of Notre Dame to complete her master's in non-profit Administration.

Besides serving with CMF, Jeff is a Kiwanis board member and the vice president of Montana Association of Mortgage Professionals.

"Jeff's financial background is a real asset to the Foundation," said CMF President Dean Comes, adding that CMF has around \$65 million in assets from donors who contributed to 300+ funds held with the Foundation.

Jeff said CMF plays an important role in allowing donors to "give back" to their communities. "Any time we can provide an opportunity for community-focused scholarships or financial solutions to assist residents to pursue financial growth and stability, we add value to making a difference for the greater good."

He continued, "CMF plays a critical role in the communities it serves. It's both humbling and an honor to have the opportunity to serve as a board member."



CMMC Cancer Center on track to open this spring

Plans to build a state-of-the-art cancer center at Central Montana Medical Center (CMMC) were announced in 2021, and just four years later, the facility is nearly complete!

The comprehensive CMMC Cancer Center will include radiation oncology on the first floor and an infusion center on the second, adding 16,712 square feet to the CMMC campus.

Crews are hard at work on the interior finishes including flooring, ceiling tiles and lighting fixtures, according to Medical Center Foundation Director Abby Franks. The majority of the interior has been painted, and some custom wall coverings will be installed before the Cancer Center's opening.

The linear accelerator and CT simulator will be delivered in late March and the month-long

installation process will begin. The target date to open the new lobby, which will serve as the main entrance and central registration, is May 5. The first radiation treatments are scheduled to begin on May 14 and the Infusion Department will be relocating to their new space on the second floor on June 2. "Once landscaping and parking lot improvements are complete, we will hold a grand opening celebration, scheduled for Friday, June 6," Abby said. "Stay tuned for more exciting details as the date nears!"

The total project cost of the CMMC Cancer Center, along with significant enhancements, is \$19.5 million. The project is funded with \$9 million from the Helmsley Charitable Trust, \$3,335,000 million from Norm Asbjornson, a matching gift of \$1 million from Larry and Kathleen Carrell,

\$500,000 from the M.J. Murdock Charitable Trust, nearly \$8.5 million from businesses and individuals, and \$2 million in interest-free debt financing by CMMC.

Donations continue to be made to support the Cancer Center. "These will held at the Foundation and will be used for ongoing needs such as future equipment replacement costs, cancer treatment advancements and growth of the facility," Abby said.

"Every gift to this campaign has been vital. Thank you, thank you, thank you to everyone who has chosen to be involved! Together is how this was achieved."

MCF donors provide funding for medical equipment and more

Thanks to the generous support of its donors, Medical Center Foundation (MCF) has been able award a number of grants and facilitate designated gifts for the Cancer Center, a new ambulance, and medical equipment at Central Montana Medical Center.

"MCF exists to support healthcare in Central Montana," said MCF Director Abby Franks. "We accomplish that through the generosity of our donors. That support improves and saves lives."

Over the past few months, MCF Advisory Board recommended the following:

- MCF granted \$2,780 from the HOPE fund to help CMMC employees in crisis. The HOPE Fund is primarily supported through employee giving and is used to help co-workers in crisis or emergency. This last quarter the HOPE Fund supported three employees.

- Per a donor designated gift the MCF transacted \$1,850,000 from the Cancer Center Fund to CMMC to support significant enhancements of the Cancer Center facility.

- Per a donor designated gift, the MCF transacted \$225,000 from CMMC's General Fund with MCF to CMMC to support the purchase of a new ambulance.

CMF grants assisting variety of causes across Central Montana

Central Montana Foundation (CMF) Board of Directors has made another round of grant awards over the last few months from income earned on its unrestricted permanent endowments: Awards include:

- **Central Montana Spirit of Christmas:** A grant of \$3,000 was awarded to purchase food, mittens, hats, and more to families in need. The group coordinates with HRDC to get referrals of families in need, and typically help about 125 low income families during the holidays. CMF has granted funds to Spirit of Christmas since 1994.

- **Catalyst for Change:** CMF awarded a grant of \$4,999 to hexpand crisis intervention services to residents in Fergus, Garfield, Judith Basin and Petroleum Counties. Crisis services are also provided by Catalyst for Change in Wheatland County. Catalyst's mission is to transform mental healthcare in rural Montana by implementing an integrated, community-based approach. Montana consistently ranks among the highest in the nation for suicide rates, with individuals in rural areas disproportionately affected by geographical isolation, stigma, and lack of mental healthcare providers.

- **Fergus Junior Class After-Prom Party:** A \$3,500 grant will help pay for costs associated with an after-prom party that offers junior and seniors from Fergus High School and their guests a safe, fun environment where they have a chance to win a plethora of prizes, play games and socialize following the prom.

- **Friendship Lodge #37:** CMF Board of Directors approved a grant for

\$1,425 to help with the Lodge's Books for Bikes Program. The funds will pay for the purchase for bikes given away to Central Montana students and ice cream for the reading party. This is an annual event sponsored by Friendship Lodge during I Love to Read month and takes place in several schools across Fergus County. Kids get tickets for reading books, and at the end of the month, a winning ticket is drawn for a new bike from True Value.

- **Cub Scout Pack #4325:** CMF granted \$757 from the Lewistown Boy Scout fund to purchase awards for the

annual Pinewood Derby. The event includes Scouts from Stanford, Harlowton and showcases their ingenuity, creativity and craftsmanship. The grant award will also help purchase tools and equipment used for building the pinewood derby cars.

- **Small Wonder Child Care:** CMF awarded a \$4,056.66 grant for the Small Wonder Safe Sleep and Play project. The grant will help replace the timeworn playpens currently used for infant sleep, with safety-approved modular crib systems with firm mattresses and fitted sheets. The modular design accommodates two cribs within the footprint of one.

CMF considers grant requests under \$5,000 at its monthly meetings and requests \$5,000 and above at its annual meeting in May. - Per a donor designated gift, the MCF transacted \$150,000 from CMMC's General Fund with MCF to CMMC to support the completion of a facility master planning process.

- MCF granted \$1,639 from CMMC's General Fund to Lewistown Public Schools to support 93 staff members across the district to supply 'to go' emergency backpacks that carry first aid supplies and other materials for when staff members are outside of the building.

- MCF worked with a donor regarding a designated gift of \$3,300 to make possible the purchase of a bilirubin blanket that is used for the treatment of neonatal jaundice in CMMC's Obstetrics Department.

- MCF worked with Donna Byerly, who retired as a clinical laboratory scientist from the CMMC Lab, on a gift of \$14,205 to purchase a new blood bank freezer which allows storage of red blood cells for up to six months. Her donation was made in honor of the people with whom she worked and also in honor of the current and future CMMC Lab staffers.
