Health Plan Members (Employee, Spouse, Dependent and Retired Employee): The cost of the health screening will be submitted to your wellness benefit Non-Plan Members: Others are welcome to attend and can purchase the screening or provide other insurance coverage

Attendees must be at least 18 and not on Medicare/Medicaid.

What is included in your screening?

- Complete Blood Count (CBC) Measures white/red blood cells, platelets, blood components
- Comprehensive Metabolic Panel (CMP) Fasting glucose, liver and kidney function
- Hemoglobin A1C Average blood glucose over the past 2-3 months
- Lipid Panel Total Cholesterol, HDL, LDL, Triglycerides
- Prostate Specific Antigen (PSA) For males meeting age criteria
- Thyroid Stimulating Hormone (TSH) Screens for hyperthyroidism and hypothyroidism
- Blood Pressure & other Vital Signs
- Body Composition and Body Mass Index (BMI)
- Personal Health Report Summary report received at your screening
- Easy-to-Read Lab Report Includes explanations of results that are out of range

Prior to your screening:

- Fast for at least 12 hours
- Drink plenty of water
- Take prescription medications as prescribed
- No strenuous exercise for 10 hours
- Do not attend if you have severe cold or flu symptoms
- Wear clothes with loose fitting sleeves
- If you are diabetic, schedule an early appointment

Additional laboratory tests:

- The ONLY additional Tests available are: Vitamin D, Hepatitis C and Blood Type
- Tests can be added during registration or at screening check-in
- These will be submitted to insurance, but if denied, an invoice will be sent to the participant.
- Cost is significantly reduced
- Your insurance company may not reimburse for additional purchased tests
